Deltans may not be able to gather around Peter Wood's dining room table this year or admire the magnificently decorated trees around his Mound Bayou home, but we can still help him celebrate the accomplishments and goals of his great passion: St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis.

Although it costs about \$2.8 million a day to run, no family ever receives a bill from St. Jude for treatment, travel, housing, or food. In their words, "All a family should worry about is helping their child live." Since it opened 50 years ago, treatments developed at St. Jude have helped push the overall childhood cancer survival rate from 20% to more than 80%.

Woods knows from personal experience how vital St. Jude's programs are: His son R.J. has received treatments for sickle cell anemia at St. Jude. R.J. has not only responded well to the treatments the family has never received even one bill. As Peter says, "How do you thank someone for that?" Well, one way is to give and to encourage others to give – so other children can receive the same benefits. With his Open House Parties the last three years – through which he raised over \$30,000 – Peter created an opportunity for generous donors to also enjoy a lavish display of Christmas décor and food.

Because of the pandemic, he's not able to host the party this year. But one less holiday party doesn't lessen the needs of the kids at St. Jude.
